1. Read mission biographies or other mission books

4. Read through the Psalms and look for every time “Nations” (ethne) is used, and note the context.
5. Show “Beyond the Gates of Splendor” DVD and have a discussion with small group
6. Join a SUS group. Select a region of interest and meet with others to SUS it out and pray. Check it out at www.mts.com.au/club5/sus.htm
